

## WEEKLY MAINTENANCE

Check pressure on filter pressure gauge and backwash the filter as needed.

Check water level in the pool. It should be  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way up the skimmer.

Check your lint pot strainer basket (at the front of the pump) and clean as needed.

Check skimmer basket for debris.

Vacuum and brush your pool.

\*This can be done more than once a week

Check that the equipment is functioning properly.

Add a daily dose of granular sanitizer if you do not have an automated chemical feeder.

## WEEKLY CHEMICAL MAINTENANCE

Test PH levels and adjust to ideal range to 7.2 – 7.8.

Test free chlorine levels and adjust to 1.0 - 3.0 ppm with your chemical feeder or 0.6 ppm if you are using a mineral purifier (Nature II).

Test Alkalinity levels to ensure they are between 80 - 120 ppm.

## OTHER SEASONAL MAINTENANCE

**Salt Cell Cleaner** - Clean cell every 3 months.

**Nature II Cartridge** - Replace at the start of each Season.

**Sand Filter** - Clean at the end of each season with Filter Free.

**Cartridge Filter** - Clean every 3 months with Cartridge Cleaner.

## CHEMICAL OVERVIEW

PRODUCTS	WHEN	HOW
Oxidizer	1 - 2 Weeks	Broadcast over surface
Unstabilized Granular Chlorine	As Needed	Broadcast over surface (some types require pre-mixing)
Unstabilized Liquid Chlorine	As Needed	Pour around perimeter of the pool water
Chlorine/Bromine Tablets	As Needed	Fill sanitizer as per manufacturer's instructions
Salt	As Needed	Pour into deep end of pool
40% Algaecide	Monthly / As Needed	Pour around perimeter of the pool water
Stain and Scale	Monthly / As Needed	Pour around perimeter of the pool water
Pool Perfect	Weekly	Pour directly into skimmer

Not all products are to be used by all pools. Consult your Pioneer Family Pools Waterlab for further instructions.

It is suggested that you have your water tested at Pioneer Family Pools every two weeks!
